

Safe & Sound Schools: State of Tennessee – Case Manager Platform & NTAC Bundle: Customer Participation

Acknowledgement Form

Safe & Sound Schools partnership with Navigate360 will be providing your district with the Behavioral Case Manager, electronic Case Management software.

This form serves to highlight the full program offerings and services provided for the length of the grant.

- Is there a cost associated with this? The value of this offer is \$3.38/student; however, it comes at **no cost to your District through our contract with Safe & Sound Schools until the end of the federal BJA STOP grant.**
- What is included in the funding? By participating in this program, districts will receive access to Navigate360's Behavioral Case Manager platform and the Navigate360 Training Institute including the National Threat Assessment Center (NTAC) bundle of courses. Districts will also receive Program Development & Operations (PDO) services to support implementing processes and procedures for a robust threat assessment program.
- What happens when Safe & Sound Schools funding ends? Districts would have the opportunity to continue the program with full continuity, by subscribing to the services. The NTAC bundle includes access to all eLearning courses in the NTAC bundle, and the Case Manager platform is \$3.38/student. Access to just the Case Manager platform is \$2.38.
- What technical resources are needed for the Case Management software? District IT Teams will work with Navigate360 to perform a Student Information System (SIS) integration to pull in required data to the Behavioral Case Manager. This data will be accessed for SIS Integration can be completed via Clever or ClassLink and will pull the following required data: Sites/Buildings, Teachers, Students, and Rosters. Data accessed from the SIS integration will be used in the Case Management software when a student is involved in the threat assessment process. Upon successful integration, multidisciplinary team members will be configured with the appropriate permissions to view and manage cases for students in their prevue.
- What other resources are available through the grant to support my district in threat assessment? As part of the grant, Navigate360, in conjunction with Safe & Sound Schools will also make available a library of implementation resources to support your threat assessment program. These resources will be made available to those who participate in the grant as well.
- Are there any other requirements to participate in the grant and receive a Behavioral Case Manager? As part of the grant, Safe & Sound Schools will be providing Level 3 threat assessment training. This training is an extension of the Level 1 and Level 2 training courses your teams have already completed. The training will address hot topics and more complex nuances that will even further prepare your teams to engage in threat assessment. It is required that teams participate in this training as part of the grant.
- What are the next steps? Districts looking to access Behavioral Case Manager will work with the Safe & Sound Schools Team- tnbtam@safeandsoundschools.org to sign up for access to the Case Management software. Once this acknowledgment form is shared with Navigate360, a member from Navigate360 will coordinate with the District Lead to begin the process. **Please submit the completed Acknowledgement Form to tnbtam@safeandsoundschools.org.**
