1. INTRODUCTION TO SEL

Audience: New customers; Teachers | **Length:** 2 hours | **Delivery Method:** Asynchronous, virtual, or in-person

Educators will build their background knowledge in social-emotional learning, understand their district's instructional model, and learn how to use Suite360 to successfully begin implementing the program with fidelity.

2. CREATING AN SEL CLIMATE IN THE CLASSROOM

3. INTRODUCTION TO SEL FOR ADMINISTRATORS

4. CREATING A SCHOOLWIDE SEL CULTURE

1. RESTORATIVE PRACTICES FOR EDUCATORS

The Restorative Practices session will define restorative practices, explain why they are important, identify restorative practices basics, and discuss best practices. Participants will also develop strategies for integrating restorative practices into their classrooms.

2. TRAUMA-INFORMED TEACHING FOR EDUCATORS

Audience: All Staff | **Length:** 2 hours | **Delivery Method:** Asynchronous, virtual, or in-person

In this course, educators will review how trauma impacts brain development and affects learning and behavior as well as learn strategies for creating a safe classroom environment. After completing this course, educators will be able to define trauma and describe ways that it impacts brain development, recognize the effect trauma has on student learning and behavior, and apply teaching strategies for building safety within the classroom environment to support students who have experienced trauma.
