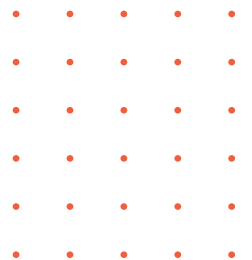




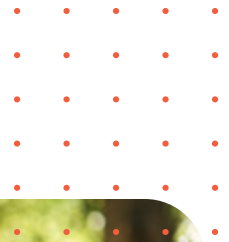
How Navigate360 Can Support Tennessee's Commitment to Comprehensive School Safety



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Tennessee leadership continues to prioritize the safety and well-being of students across the state with legislation such as [Executive Order 97](#), the [SAVE Act](#), and the [Safe Schools Act](#).

An Overview of Tennessee School Safety Standards

Executive Order 97

Resources For Parents:

- Creation of a School Safety Resource and Engagement Guide
- Promotion of Safe TN app for anonymously reporting safety concerns

Standards For Schools:

- Guidance from state agencies on best practices for implementing annual school security assessments
- Increased unannounced audits of building security
- Direction to request permission from the federal government to use existing federal ESSER funds to conduct independent safety assessments
- Reappropriation of staff to focus on safety, mental health and family and community engagement
- Development of additional school safety training and educational materials for educators and school leaders

Updates For Law Enforcement:

- Recommended evaluation of training standards by the Department of Commerce & Insurance
- Assessment by the Department of Commerce & Insurance of the need for active-shooter training for armed guards in non-public schools
- Implementation of increased requirement efforts



Schools Against Violence in Education (SAVE) Act

The purpose of this legislation is to establish standards that create a supportive learning environment in order to reduce potential risks to the greatest extent possible through a comprehensive emergency operations plan that must include the following:

- Written code of conduct, including policies to prevent and respond to harassment and bullying
- Formal procedures to receive, investigate, and respond to threats, acts of violence, or any misconduct
- Clearly established roles and responsibilities for school resource officers
- Formal policies governing who is allowed on school campuses, check in/out process for visitors, and required criminal background checks for all teachers and employees working in close proximity of children
- Implementation of procedures to ensure regular emergency drills are conducted
- Formal procedures for responding to firearms on campus that include immediately notifying local law enforcement



Safe Schools Act

This act established funds for all public schools to implement solutions that will decrease the likelihood of violent or disruptive behavior and to protect students and staff from harm when such behavior may occur. The money can be spent on the following:

- Facility security & planning
- School safety personnel
- Violence prevention
- Training & drills
- Behavioral health

The CARE Project: Providing Behavioral Threat Assessment (BTA) & Suicide Prevention Training at No Cost to Tennessee Districts!

The CARE Project – which stands for **C**onnect **A**ssess **R**espond **E**ngage – is led by Learning Forward Tennessee in collaboration with the Tennessee Organization of School Superintendents (TOSS), Navigate360, the Tennessee School Safety Center, and Safe and Sound Schools.

Funded by a grant from the U.S. Department of Justice and Bureau of Justice Assistance, the CARE Project provides Behavioral Threat Assessment and Suicide Prevention Training at no cost to an estimated 900 school community teams in Tennessee.

BTA training was originally developed by the U.S. Secret Service and the U.S. Department of Education to assist schools in identifying and intervening with students or other members of the school community whose behavior indicates they may pose a threat to themselves or others. Threat assessment protocols are recognized as a best practice in school safety. Additionally, Tennessee schools are authorized by state law to establish BTA teams in collaboration with local law enforcement entities and are protected from liability when acting within the scope and function of these teams.

Tennessee law also requires districts to develop suicide prevention policies and training. The CARE Project provides an accessible option for that state's districts and schools to participate in training related to these important practices.

Directors who wish for their district to participate in this program are asked to identify a district-level point of contact to coordinate team recruitment and registration.
