What is Hall Pass Plus?

Available as an add-on to the PBIS Rewards platform, Hall Pass Plus provides you with a quick and easy way to view which students are absent or out of class at any given time throughout the day. Whether managing routine trips or monitoring high-risk students, this digital hall pass for schools replaces outdated systems with smart technology that supports safer, more structured learning environments. Built for PBIS Rewards schools, Hall Pass Plus fits seamlessly into your existing behavior management framework, helping you promote and maintain a positive schoolwide culture.

Who is Hall Pass Plus for?

Hall Pass Plus is for PBIS Rewards schools who are looking to improve hallway accountability, reduce behavior incidents, and better manage student movement throughout the day.

What Tools are Available to Reduce Hallway Disruptions?

There are several features in Hall Pass Plus that are designed to reduce hallway disruptions and keep students in the classroom. Set building-wide pass limits, individual pass limits, and block specific groups of students from being out on a pass at the same time, reducing bullying, loitering, and other safety risks.

- Limits Set the number of total passes that can be issued at the same time for the building
 as well as the number of total hall passes a student can be issued per day.
- Blocking Block specific combinations of students from being on a hall pass at the same time.



Can Students See & Manage Their Own Pass Usage?

The platform displays how many passes a student has used for the day (e.g. 3/5 passes), helping them stay aware of their limits and make responsible choices. While students can't issue their own passes from the portal, they can scan in and out using a kiosk if enabled by the school, streamlining the process while keeping staff in control.

• Self-Serve Kiosks - Generate a code that turns any mobile device into a self-serve station where students can scan their badge to be placed on or taken off a hall pass.

How Does Hall Pass Plus Help Schools Track Patterns Over Time?

Robust reporting capabilities allow schools to view hall pass data by student, grade level, location, or time of day for custom date ranges. Teams can easily identify patterns such as frequent hallway use, extended time out of class, or recurring student meetups. These insights can be used to guide early interventions, adjust policies, and better support student needs.

- Moniter Time Out of Class Easily view how much time students are spending outside of the classroom on a schoolwide and individual level.
- Homepage Visibility See all the students currently on a hall pass, including their name, location, and elapsed time, all from the homepage.
- Individual Limit Visibility Staff and students can see how many hall passes the student has been issued for the day based on the student limit.
- Meetup Reports See students with the highest frequency of overlapping hall
 passes, allowing staff to quickly identify and block students who should not be on a
 pass together.



How Can These Insights Be Used to Promote Positive Behavior & Support Early Intervention?

Insights provided in the reporting dashboards help staff pinpoint when and where students may need additional support. Trends in frequent hallway use, extended time out of class, and repeated patterns across specific days or class periods may indicate deeper problems, like disengagement, concerning social dynamics, or unmet emotional needs. Identifying these patterns enables teams to use data to guide proactive interventions. Over time, this builds a culture of accountability, minimizes disruptions, and encourages more consistent positive behavior throughout your school.
